

## **APPLICATION FEE & INSPECTION FEE ARE MANDATORY**

(Unless a set fee has been established.)

### **ELECTRICAL PERMITS:**

Explanations:

- Whenever a new service is being installed, a feeder fee of \$5.00 is added to the application.
- Circuits- 120 V is \$4.00 per breaker- not per box/outlet. Six boxes are allowed per circuit breaker.
- Lighting fixtures are \$6.00 per 25. Please mark accordingly. If you have 10 fixtures- mark 1 in the quantity box not 10.
- Furnace- Unit heater is marked on the electrical permit if it is an electrical heater.
- Power outlets are \$6.00 per 220V outlet.
- Smoke Detectors are to be hard wired in a series with a battery backup. There is no inspection for these. Fire Alarms on the permit application refer to commercial structures.

### **MECHANICAL PERMITS:**

Explanations:

- Residential Heating System is \$35.00 and it includes the Duct and Piping (they do not need to be marked separately on the permit application.)
- A boiler's license is required to pull a mechanical permit for a boiler.
- Residential Air Conditioning is \$20.00.
- Gas piping up to 4 outlets is mandatory for any gas hookups.
- Bathroom & Kitchen Exhausts are \$4.00 each.
- Propane Tanks will be paid for by the company setting the tank.
- Unit Heater marked on the mechanical Permit if it is a gas heater.
- Commercial Boilers need to be pulled through the State of Michigan.

### **PLUMBING PERMITS:**

Explanations:

- See "Plumbing Fixtures" on the back of the permit application for help in figuring fixtures, floor drains, & water-connected appliances.
- Most applications include Water Service less than 2", Building Drain/Sewer Connections and 3/4" Water Distributing Pipe.
- Mark anything else that applies.
